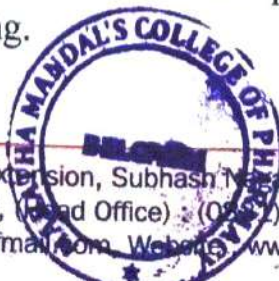

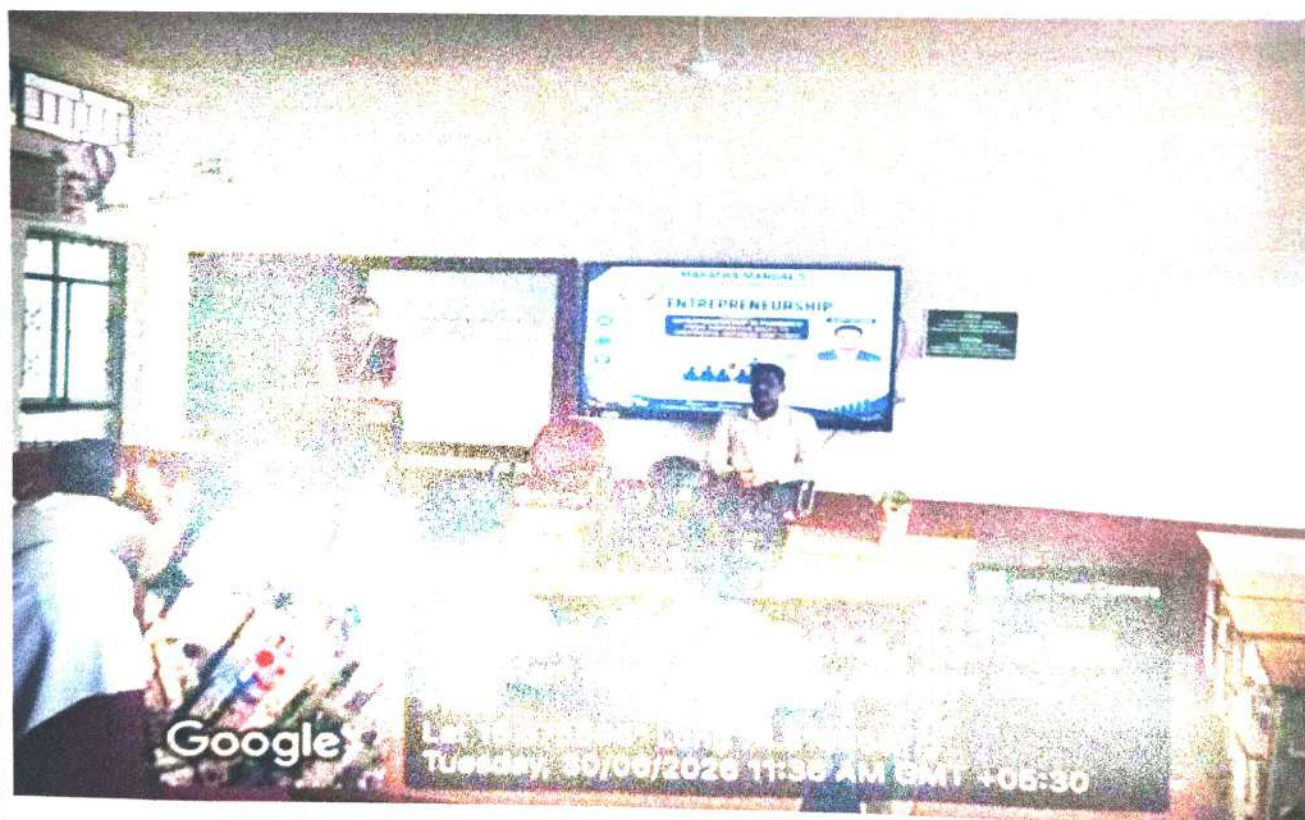
The seminar concluded with a vote of thanks by the event coordinators, who expressed sincere gratitude to the guest speaker for sharing his valuable knowledge and experiences.
