5. All painting and tattoo materials should be arranged and brought by the participants themselves.
6. The artwork should be original, creative, and suitable for an academic and cultural environment.
7. Participants must complete their work within the allotted time.
8. Any form of tracing, use of stencils, or assistance from others is strictly prohibited.
9. Participants are expected to maintain discipline, cleanliness, and proper conduct throughout the event.
10. The decision of the organizing committee regarding the competition results will be final and binding.

Evaluation Criteria: Creativity and Originality, Relevance to Theme, Artistic Skill, and Overall Presentation.

 - **Nature**
 - **Organs**
 - **Flowers Design**
- 5 Use of mobile phones, reference books, or internet resources during the competition is not allowed.
- 6 Drawing sheets will be provided by the organizers (or specify if participants should bring their own).
- 7 Time duration: 2 hours (or as decided by organizers).
- 8 Participants must write their name, class, and roll number on the back of the sheet.
- 9 Any medium (watercolor, poster color, acrylic, oil pastel, etc.) may be used unless otherwise specified.
- 10 Judges' decision will be final and binding.
- 11 Maintain discipline and cleanliness throughout the event.
